## SUBSTANCE ABUSE

### WHAT YOU SHOULD KNOW

Substance Abuse (SA) is the excessive use of a substance; either illegal drugs, alcohol or prescription medication. Substance abuse can lead to physical, emotional and psychological harm to both the abuser and other individuals as well.

#### COMMONLY ABUSED SUBSTANCES

Commonly abused drugs include;

- Alcohol
- Tobacco
- Marijuana
- Stimulants like Cocaine and Methamphetamine (Meth).
- Club drugs like Ecstasy, Ketamine and Rophynol.
- Hallucinogens like LSD and Mushroom.
- Narcotic pain killers like Codeine, Tramadol and Morphine.
- Inhalants like Glue, Lighter fluid, Paint thinner and Gasoline
- Tranquilizers like Valium and Ativan.
- Over the counter drugs like cough syrup and decongestants.

#### SIGNS OF SUBSTANCE ABUSE

Some signs of substance abuse include;

- 1) Changes in behavior like increased aggression, lack of motivation, irritability.
- 2) Frequently missing out on school or work.
- 3) Loss of interest in personal hygiene and grooming.
- 4) Unusual spending and borrowing to feed the addiction.
- 5) Individuals develop unusual and unhealthy relationships.
- 6) Individuals may withdraw and isolate themselves in order to hide their addiction.
- 7) Blood shot eyes or frequent bloody nose.
